Kumite and Kata

Thursday, 15th September 2016

09.00 – 12.00 – Theory and examination (Hotel Minichmayr)

13.00 – 16.00 – Practice and examination (Stadthalle Steyr)

REFEREE'S BRIEFING (for Referees and Judges who have already EGKF/WGKF accreditation)

Thursday, 15th September 2016

16.00 – 17.00 - Referees briefing (Hotel Minichmayr)

I draw your attention to these events since without EGKF Referees in the event we will be unable to run a proper competition and it is mandatory for each team to travel with, at least, 2 referees (next Congress will decide on penalties for countries who fail to do so). Until now only 14 countries (less than two thirds of our members) have EGKF Referees.

Both events are ruled by our Referee Committee, headed by Sensei Uwe Portugall, and the fee's are for Course 100 € and Briefing 35 €.
