The "Wild Card" is a tournament entry awarded to an individual that fails to qualify in the normal way (but considered having a high ranking or winning a qualifying stage). One per nation will be given and chosen freely by the leader of each nation.
- The organizing committee wishes to have your Nation's confirmation of participation, once you have received the Championship Details.
